18	WHEREAS, Non-citizens compose a significant portion of the
19	Armed Forces, enlisting more than 8,000 persons annually; and
20	WHEREAS, According to the Department of Defense, more than

1	65,000 non-citizen immigrants were serving in the United States
2	Armed Forces as of 2008, accounting for at least 5% of the
3	total active-duty personnel; and
4	WHEREAS, The Immigration Reform Act of 1996 broadened the
5	criteria for removable offenses to include shoplifting,

misdemeanor drug offenses, and other minor offenses, allowing

WHEREAS, The Restoring Respect for Immigrant Service in

Uniform Act prevents the deportation of veterans who have
