2 The Wyoming legislature is hereby declared to be 3 the appropriate legislative authority of the state in 4 accordance with 45 C.F.R. part 400 with exclusive authority to designate a state agency to develop and administer, or 5 supervise the administration of, any refugee resettlement 6 plan and to designate a state coordinator to be responsible 7 8 for coordination of public and private resources in refugee act "refugee 9 resettlement. For purposes of this 10 resettlement plan" means any written description of a 11 refugee or asylum seeking resettlement program or any 12 commitment by the governor or any designee of the governor 13 to administer or supervise the administration of a refugee 14 or asylum seeking resettlement program pursuant to the 15 Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1521 et seq.

(b) The governor or any designee of the governor shall rescind all refugee resettlement plans or agreements submitted to the office of refugee resettlement within the United States department of health and human services prior to the effective date of this act. No refugee resettlement plan for refugees to be placed in the state of Wyoming shall be effective until the refugee resettlement plan is

submitted to and approved by the legislature as provided 1 2 under subsections (c) and (d) of this section. 3 4 (c) The governor or any designee of the governor shall submit any refugee resettlement plan to 5 the legislature for approval. Any refugee resettlement plan 6 submitted to the legislature shall provide: 7 8 9 (i) A description of how the state intends to 10 encourage effective refugee resettlement and to promote 11 economic self-sufficiency of refugees as quickly as 12 possible; 13 14 (ii) A description of how the state will insure 15 that language training and employment services are made 16 available to refugees receiving cash assistance; 17 18 (iii) A recommendation for the designation of an 19 individual, employed by the state, who will be responsible

for ensuring coordination of public and private resources

in refugee resettlement;

1 (iv) For the care and supervision of, and legal 2 responsibility for, unaccompanied refugee children in the 3 state; 4 5 (v) For the identification of refugees who at the time of resettlement in the state have 6 conditions requiring, or medical histories indicating a 7 8 need for, treatment or observation and for any monitoring 9 of such treatment or observation as may be necessary; 10 11 description of funds necessary to (vi) A 12 implement the refugee resettlement plan and a complete 13 description of projected federal or private funds available 14 to carry out the refugee resettlement plan including reimbursements, grants and contracts. The description 15 16 shall include a timeline for receipt and expenditure of funds and a projection of any state funds necessary to 17 18 implement the refugee resettlement plan after all 19 reimbursements, grants and contracts are exhausted. 20 21 (d) Upon receipt, the legislature's management 22 council shall assign the refugee resettlement plan to a joint interim committee and the committee shall review the 23

- 1 plan and convene public hearings to receive comments from
- 2 Wyoming citizens, local government representatives,
- 3 volunteer agencies and other interested parties on the
- 4 plan. The committee shall report recommendations for
- 5 consideration by the legislature in the next legislative
- 6 session and may develop and introduce legislation to
- 7 implement or authorize any refugee resettlement plan.

- 9 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
- 10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
- 11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
- 12 Constitution.
